

What to Do

DIRECTIONS:

- **From the Main Entrance:** ask to be directed to the In-House Clinic - follow red arrows on the floor and signs to the Ground Floor Clinic
- **From the Park Street Entrance:** located directly across from Dental Center; the In-House Clinic is right inside the door

CHECKING IN:

- **No appointments:** First come first seen basis
- **Check in at the In-House Clinic registration desk** located on the Ground Floor.

PAYMENT OPTIONS:

- **Medicaid, Medicare, and most insurances accepted**
- **Co-Pays are expected at the time services are provided**

Examples of “Non Life-threatening” Medical Concerns

- Allergy or hay fever
- Cuts or bruises
- Dental problems
- Ear pain
- Foot problems - blisters, ingrown toenails, plantar warts
- Joint pain
- Lice or scabies
- Mild back pain, able to walk without assistance
- Mild cough
- Mild eye irritations - without signs of infection or history of foreign body
- Minor headaches
- Minor skin infection, sores
- Mouth blisters
- Muscle aches/pains
- Pregnancy testing
- Rash - simple, localized
- Sore throat
- Sunburn - without blisters
- Suture removal
- Tetanus shot
- Wound checks
