- Minimum 2.5 GPA (C+)
- Provide up-to-date vaccination and health records
- Be punctual & dependable
- Be willing to accept supervision
- Respect confidentiality of patients and residents
- Complete volunteer orientation
- Complete nursing competency requirements as determined by nursing administration
- Receive referral from guidance counselor
